CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Textile wallcovering is decorative and requires more care in cleaning. Extra care and precautions must be taken to keep material clean and free of job dirt and adhesive. Occasional vacuuming will remove most of the dirt and lint and maintain the product's fresh look and appearance.

Ordinary dirt spots can be removed with a mild soap and warm water. Rinse thoroughly with clean water. Blot wallcovering dry with a soft, lint-free towel. For more difficult stains that are only surface deep, the use of a stronger detergent is recommended. Try an inconspicuous spot first before attempting the entire wall. One should always rinse after applying a detergent. Abrasive rubbing of spots should be avoided so discoloration cannot appear.

Do not use active solvent-type cleaning preparation, such as nail polish remover, tar and bug removers, etc., because they may damage the wallcovering.

Teflon is applied to this clean, smooth surface causing water and oil based stains to bead up on the fabric. In most cases, it can be cleaned with water based cleaning products. In case of color stains, it is important to remove those as soon as possible especially because the finish is porous and does not prevent ultimate penetration into the fabric.
